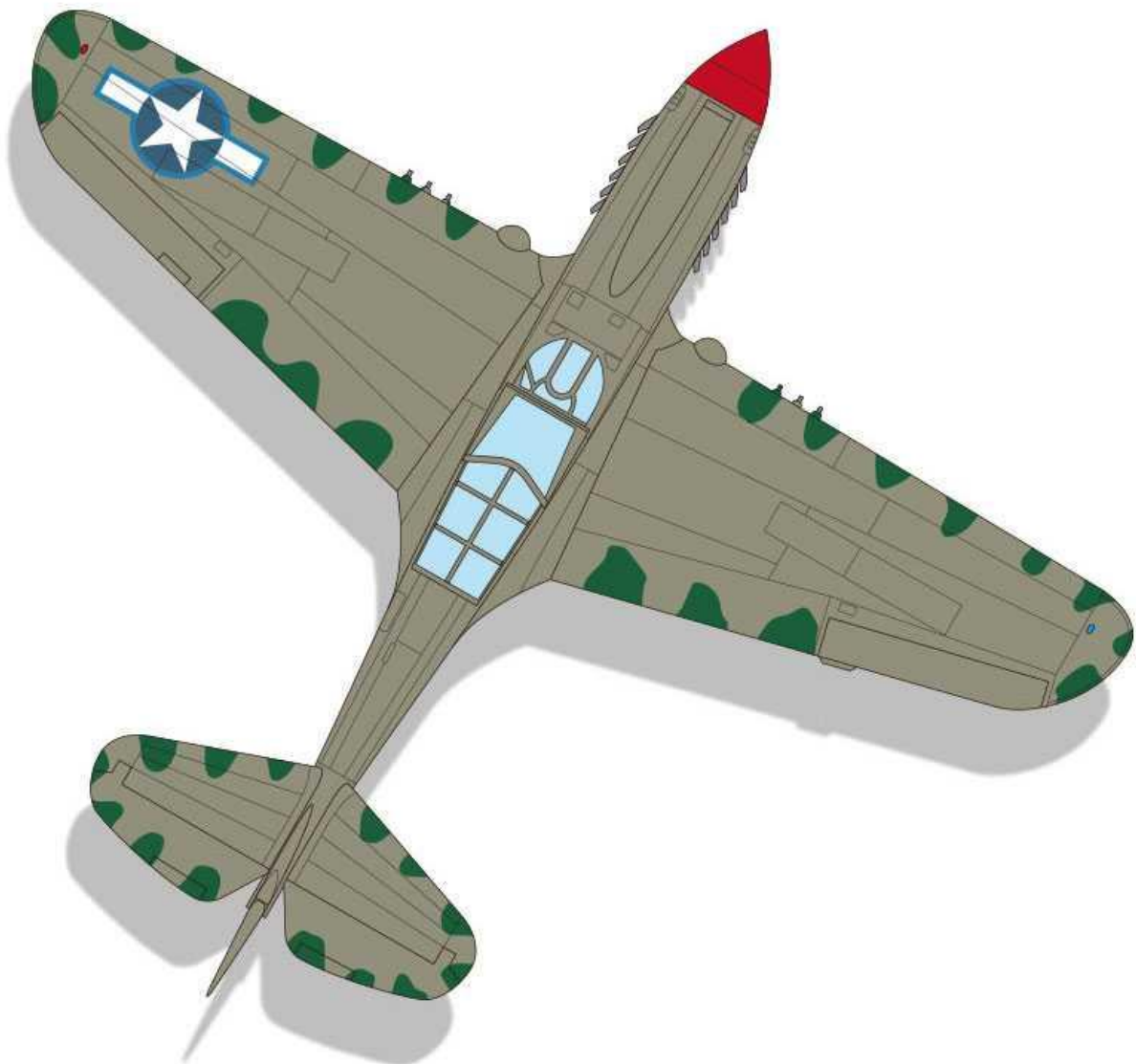
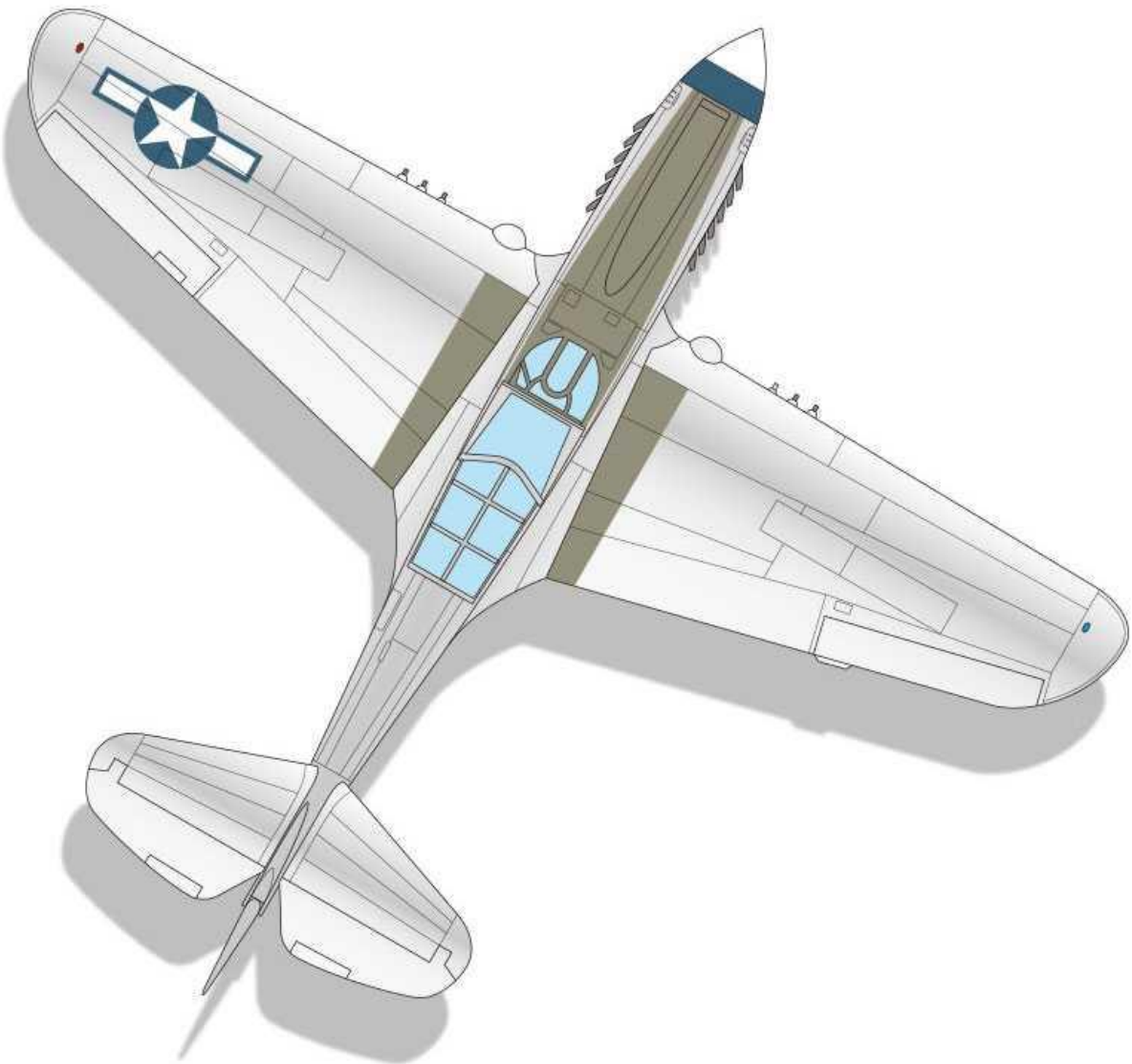
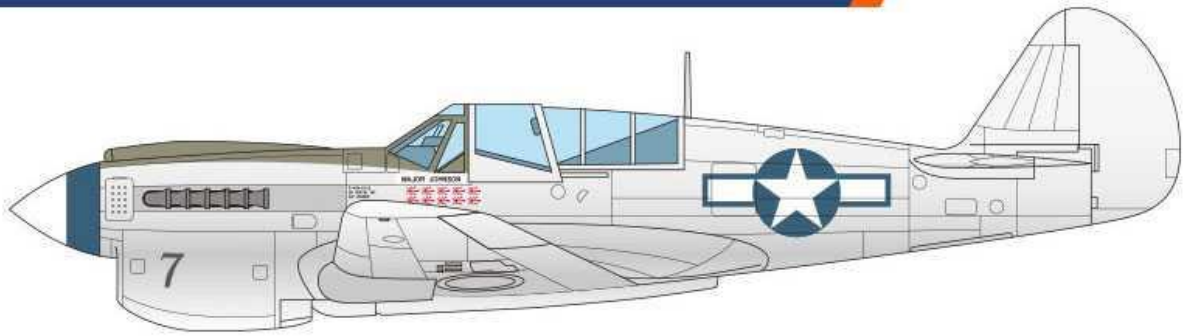


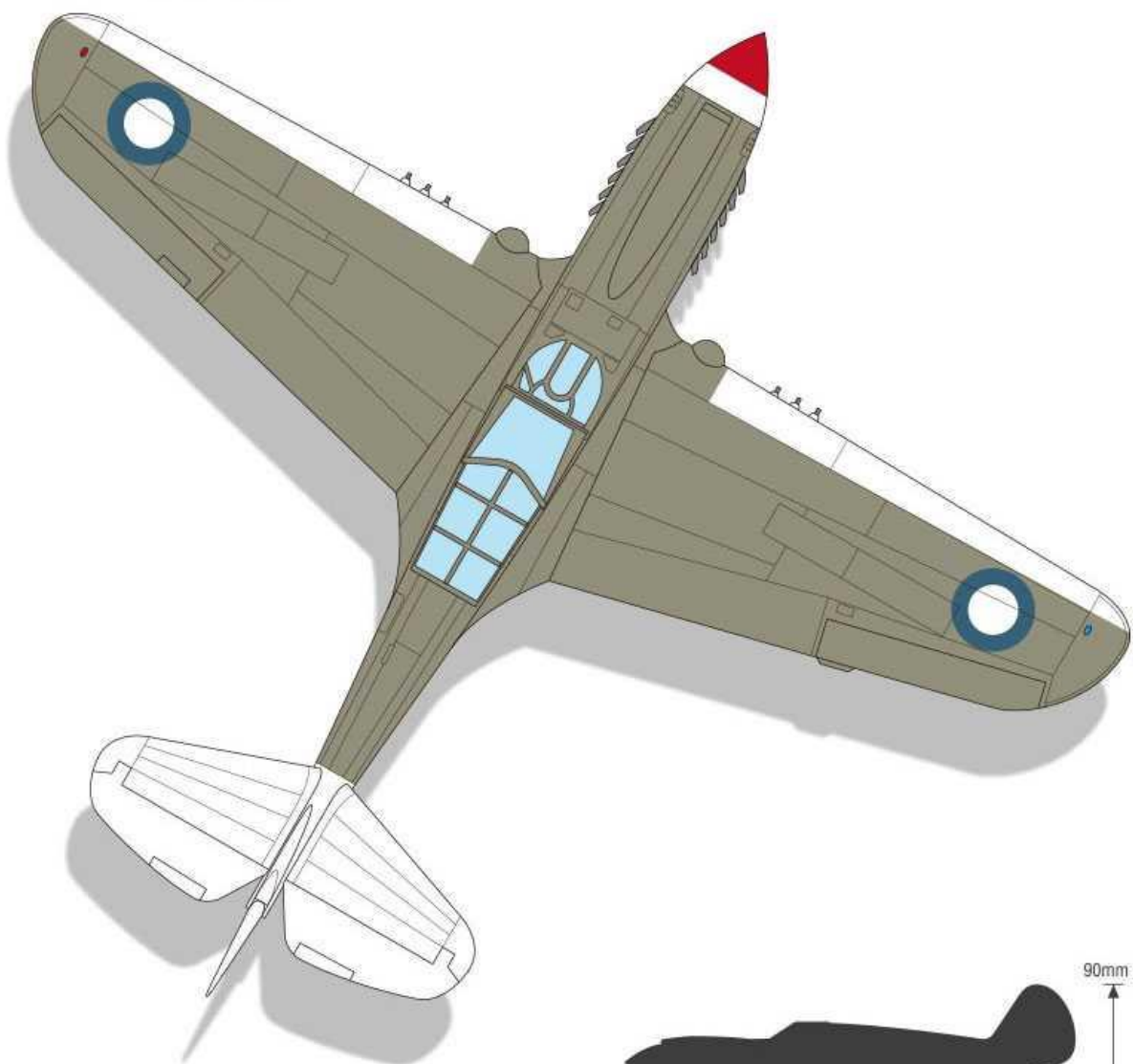
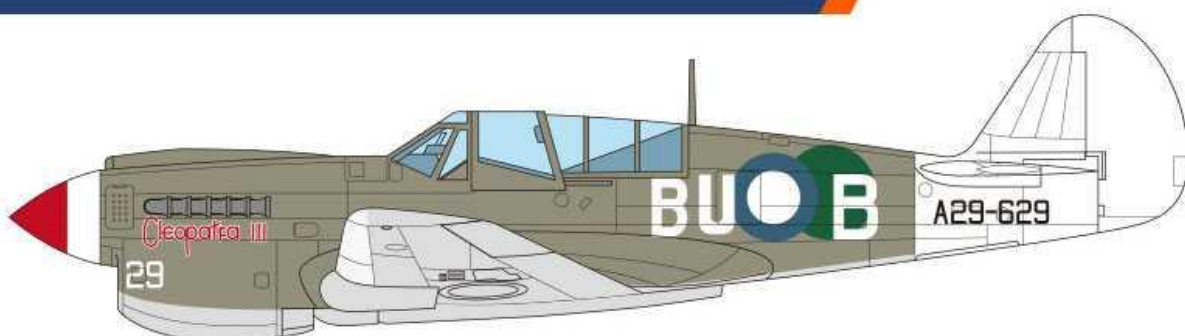
"Lulu belle", P-40N-5 42-105128 of 2nd Lt. Philip Adair.
